

## **DCTC Policy 5.31 Visitors to the Campus**

### **Part 1. Policy Statement.**

Citizens are encouraged to visit the college campus during operating hours.

For purpose of this policy, a visitor to the college shall mean a person other than a student enrolled, a staff member assigned, or a participant in a community service activity at the college. Operating hours shall mean such times as any college sponsored or approved activity or event is occurring.

It is prohibited for any person to remain in a college building, or upon college grounds, after being requested to leave by any person in lawful control of the building or grounds.

It is prohibited for any person to return to the school building or grounds after a request to leave has been made until that request is revoked or rescinded by the college president or other person in lawful control of the building and grounds.

It is prohibited for any person on college premises to annoy, disturb, interfere with, or obstruct any classroom instruction, teaching program, or other college program or assembly being conducted upon the premises.
