Class A Truck Driver Training

Daytime Basic Driver Program - 180 hours

Cost: \$4,500 Time: 7 a.m. - 3 p.m. Days: Monday - Friday
Program begins first Monday of February, April, June, August, October and December.

Evening Basic Driver Program - 180 hours

Cost: \$4,500 Time: 5 p.m. - 10 p.m. Days: Monday - Friday

Program Requirements:

1. **Obtain a Department of Transportation Physical Exam and Drug Test.**
Contact your doctor, or call a NowCare Medical Center for a discounted price. The NowCare-Eagan office number is 651-686-6442. We need to see both the 3-page Medical Report AND the Health Certificate.
2. **Obtain a copy of your driving record (MVR).**
Contact any law enforcement agency, or contact the Department of Public Safety at mndriveinfo.org or 651-284-1234.
3. **Obtain a Class A CDL learner's permit.**
Visit any License Bureau or Exam Station and request a copy of the MN Commercial Driver's Manual. You must pass 4 tests: General Knowledge (Introduction, Driving Safely, and Transporting Cargo Safely); Air Brakes; Combination Vehicles, and Pre-Trip Inspection.
4. **Attend an Information Visit with Truck Driver Training staff.**
This is optional, but highly recommended. Call 651-423-8292 for details.
5. **Apply for loans, or declare payment arrangements by the start of class.**

Class B Truck Driver Training

DCTC offers regularly scheduled Class B CDL training. The cost of the program is \$750 per student with a minimum of three students per session.

- 24 hours of training in three days, 12 sessions per year (call for dates)
- Manual transmission straight truck, dump truck, cement mixer, and automatic passenger bus
- We set your license exam appointment – you test with our truck and professional instructor
- DCTC certificate of completion, with a success rate exceeding 96%

Individual 12-hour one-on-one session can be scheduled for \$995.00.
