

DCTC Policy 5.30 Precinct Caucuses and Elections

Part 1. Policy Statement.

Campus Scheduling on Precinct Caucus Evenings (M.S. 202A.19)

SUBD 3 provides ... No Minnesota State college or university may schedule an event which will take place after 6:00 p.m. on the day of a major political party precinct caucus unless permission to do so has been received from the Board of Trustees of Minnesota State.

Public Meetings Prohibited on Election Day (M.S. 204C.03)

SUBD. 2 Except for regularly scheduled classes, no Minnesota State college or university shall schedule an event between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the day that an election is held in any political subdivision in which the university or college is located.
