Chapter 6 – Facilities Management

6.11 – Parking

Part 1. Policy Statement

Authority for establishing traffic and parking regulations and procedures on the state college campuses is granted to the state college campuses by Minnesota Statute Section 169.966 and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnSCU) Board Regulations. The goal of this policy and related procedures is to provide a safe and secure parking facility to meet the needs of the students, staff, and guests of Dakota County Technical College (DCTC).

Part 2. Applicability

The regulations and procedures apply to DCTC only. Streets in and around campus are governed by state law and city ordinances.

Part 3. Parking Committee

The Vice President of Finance and Operations will establish a Parking Committee comprised of a representative from each of the bargaining units, employee plans, and the Student Senate to serve in an advisory function to the President in the establishment of traffic and parking regulations, procedures and fees.

Part 4. Employee Fees

All policies and fees relating to employee parking shall be uniform for all employees.
