

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP

GREAT NEWS! The Minnesota legislature approved Workforce Development Scholarships for 2019-2020. DCTC students admitted to select *manufacturing, healthcare and information technology programs* leading to high demand occupations are strongly encouraged to apply for one of seven **\$2,500** scholarships. Details regarding eligibility criteria and award process are below:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- New students admitted to a qualified program (see list below). Preference for recent high school graduates.
- A resident of Minnesota
- Enroll in (at least) nine credits Fall 2019 and Spring 2020
- Fill out the online scholarship application between Jan. 1st - March 15th, 2019
- Preference given to students demonstrating financial need so applicants must complete the 2019-2020 FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov
- Maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher

TO APPLY:

Step 1: Complete DCTC's admission process into a qualifying program

Step 2: Apply for the scholarship at <http://www.dctc.edu/scholarships/>

Step 3: Enroll in at least nine credits for Fall semester 2019

Selected recipients will be notified of their award by April 1, 2019 via email. Awards will be disbursed in half amounts (\$1,250 for fall, \$1,250 for spring). To receive the spring portion, recipients *must* maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA and enroll in nine credits (or more) second semester.
