DCTC celebrates completion of renovations for Transportation & Emerging Technologies programs

Thanks to Governor Mark Dayton and the Minnesota State Legislature, Dakota County Technical College is celebrating the completion of Phase II of the college's Transportation & Emerging Technologies Renovation project. Phase I of the project was completed in 2013 due to a successful \$7.2 million capital bonding request. In 2014, DCTC started work on Phase II of the project, applying funds from a successful \$7.6 million bonding request.

A ribbon-cutting ceremony will be held in Dakota Room A on the college's main campus in Rosemount, Minnesota, Wednesday, January 24, 2018, from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. After brief remarks, attendees can take tours of the renovated areas, including the Central Commons, Nanoscience Lab, Heavy Duty Truck Technology and Heavy Construction Equipment Technology. Cookies and lemonade will be served in Dakota Room A. Students, staff, alumni, faculty and the general public are invited.
