

DCTC Policy 3.44 Degree Granting Authority

Part 1. Policy Statement.

Recognition

The Board of Trustees recognizes four broad classes of institutions within Minnesota State: community colleges, community/technical college, technical colleges, and state universities.

Authority Delegation

The Board of Trustees delegates authority to the College to award A.S., and A.A.S. degrees, diplomas, and certificates and to offer the educational programming required to support these awards.

Authority to award a specific degree/type of degree is explicitly granted by Minnesota State Policy 3.25. An institution may petition to offer a degree for which specific authority is not granted in the mentioned policy by successfully completing a detailed proposal/plan.
