

Connecting to eduroam on Apple iOS

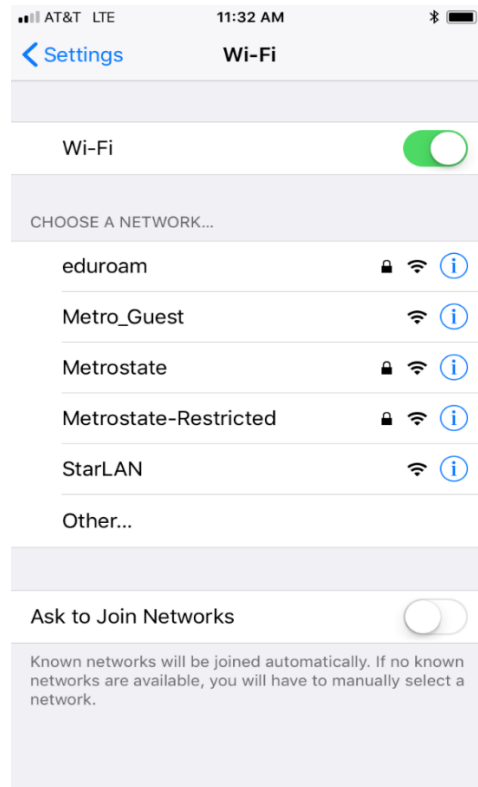
If your Apple iOS device has already connected to eduroam before August 2023, please forget the network before proceeding.

This article will walk you through the configuration and setup of the eduroam wireless network on an Apple iOS device such as an iPhone or an iPad.

1. From the iOS home screen, select the "Settings" app.
2. In the Settings app, select the "Wi-Fi" menu.

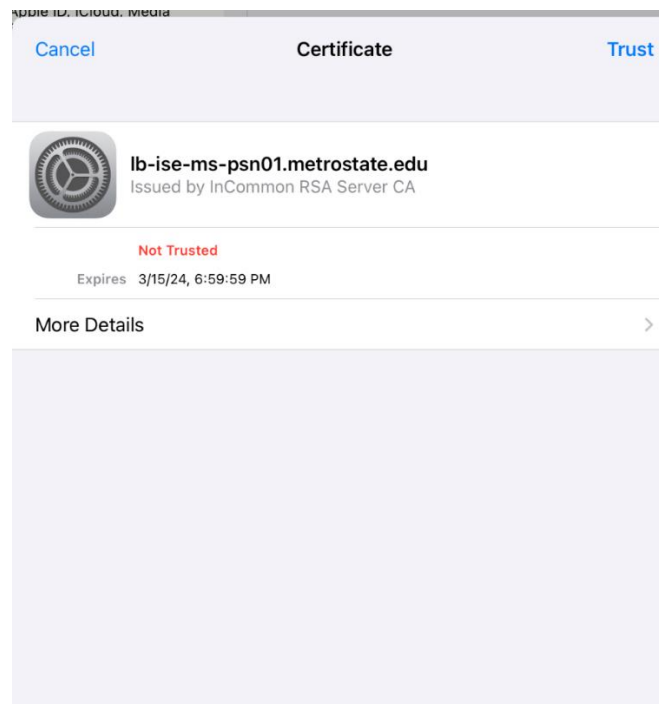


3. From the list of available WiFi networks, select "eduroam".



4. Use login credentials, username: **StarID@go.minnstate.edu** (students) or **StarID@minnstate.edu** (staff) and enter your **StarID password** and select **Join**.

5. You may be prompted with the following screen. If so, you are receiving this screen because the Root Certificate Authority which signed the authentication server's identity certificate is not trusted by your device. This is normal. Please ensure the certificate name ends in "metrostate.edu" and the certificate is "Issued by InCommon RSA Server CA". Once confirmed select the "Trust" option in the top right-hand corner of the screen.



6. You will now be connected to eduroam.
