

Call 911

**Submit a CARE referral after the 911 call*

- ◇ Attack/assault/threatening behavior that poses an immediate safety threat to self, others, and/or campus environment
- ◇ Medical emergency
- ◇ Use of illegal substance and/or other criminal behaviors
- ◇ Suicidal ideation with a plan and access to lethal means
- ◇ Witness to any of the above

For non-911 situations concerning the student's well-being, please submit a CARE referral via <https://www.dctc.edu/support-services/care-team/>. Examples, but not limited to, are:

- ◇ Any classroom misconduct and/or disruption to the learning environment
- ◇ Homelessness and/or barriers relating to food, clothing, transportation
- ◇ Excessive exhaustion, falling asleep in class repeatedly
- ◇ Loss of interest, lack of energy or difficulty concentrating
- ◇ More socially withdrawn or animated than usual
- ◇ Disturbing content in student work or its presentation
- ◇ Trouble with interpersonal or professional boundaries
- ◇ Severe anxiety or depression
- ◇ Expressed suicidal ideation without a clear plan and/or access to lethal means
- ◇ Past trauma or recent crisis
- ◇ Elevated/unmanageable stress
- ◇ Anything that relates to the student's basic needs and wellness
- ◇ Incidents of bias or discrimination relating to race, class, gender, or religion identity
